Dear Parents and Friends of The King's School Community,

We are writing to let you know about how you can get involved in an exciting local event on **Saturday 2nd July 2011.**

The Harvey 100 is a 100km (62.5 mile) FLAT cycle ride; the route is circular on roads in the Cotswold area; there is also a shorter (40 mile) 'Family Fun' route. Participants' sponsorship goes to 'Hop Skip & Jump' play and support centres. **The Harvey 100 will help the charity as it aims to:**

- Open two more HS&J centres to support families further afield
- Improve immediate access to flexible, sustained day care respite

The King's School's involvement in The Harvey 100 has been inspired by one of our pupils, Harvey (pictured here completing a 100km bike ride earlier this year). As our Captain he has received a positive response from pupils and staff; many have verbally committed to cycling (& training!) or helping out on the day. He has already secured some corporate sponsorship!

As a member of The King's School community there are several ways you can get support this venture:

What do I need to know as a Harvey 100 cyclist?

Details and registration for the event will soon be available on our website. All terms and conditions are found on the online registration form. All you need to take part is a roadworthy bicycle, helmet (compulsory) and day sac plus a refillable water bottle (this year's King's School Young Enterprise group is selling these in support of this event); a mobile phone is also recommended. Some snacks and refreshments will be provided on the ride though a small amount of cash for lunch/further supplies en route will also be useful. **The aim is for us to raise as much as possible; ALL monies go to HS&J!**

Hop, Skip & Jump provides an environment for children with physical, learning, and emotional disabilities, where they are able to interact freely, gaining confidence, self esteem and social skills.

It offers parents, siblings and carers the opportunity to take a well earned break or meet with others to share experiences and also gain advice from experts. The two existing centres (Cheltenham and Bristol) receive around 31,000 visits every year.

We understand that the event organisers have already secured media interest in coverage of The Harvey 100. It is hoped that 'Team KINGS' in our blue and gold cycling jerseys, will make quite an impact—we have the potential to be the largest (by far) of the groups taking part.
